

Dress and Grooming (All Secondary Levels)

The district’s dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, prevent disruption, and minimize safety hazards. Students and parents may determine a student’s personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the following:

<p>Skirts</p> <p>Jumpers</p> <p>Dresses</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid Colors (Khaki, Navy Blue, Black, Brown, White, Grey) • top of the knee or longer, kick pleats or slits hemmed at or below the bend of the knee 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Low rise, tight, Denim, spandex, low cut
<p>Shirts</p> <p>Blouses</p> <p>Turtlenecks</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid collared shirt • La Vega spirit shirt permitted on any day • Collared polo or dress style shirt, long or short sleeves, • Must be tucked in if longer than finger-tip length • Collared college logo permitted on any day. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No more than 2 buttons undone • Visible logos no more than 3 inch high 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Athletic jerseys, tank tops, halters, tube tops, t-shirts stripes, checks, lettering, wording or designs • No brads, studs or zippers



EXCEPTION: College wear-designated by school as approved by Administration

Belts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If pants/slacks/shorts have belt loops, belt must be worn • Must be black or brown or same color as pants/slacks 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No oversize belt buckles or buckles with graphics • No chain belts
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes, loafers, boots, dress shoes, closed toe slides, sandals with a back strap • Athletic shoes as long as shoe laces match 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flip-flops, house shoes, Bedroom slippers, athletic sandals, shower sandals, • Heels higher than 3" high
Socks Tights Leggings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid Colors (Khaki, Navy Blue, Black, Brown, White, Grey). • Solid single colors or design must match . 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leg warmers, leggings without an approved dress code dress, jumper or skirt over them, patterns are not permitted.
Outer wear Jackets Sweaters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid Color preferred; approved dress code shirt or top must be worn underneath. • School letter jackets are acceptable. Jackets/Coats finger- tip length only 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Knee length or longer jackets, dusters
Sweatshirts Hoodies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid color sweatshirts or hoodies, fingertip length or shorter • Hoodies must remain off head at school at all times 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No oversized sweatshirts. • Approved top must be worn under sweatshirt or hoodie.
Headwear		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No hats, caps, do-rags, bandanas toboggans, sweatbands, head coverings, or sunglasses are permitted

UNACCEPATABLE DRESS & GROOMING

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any hairstyle that is not neat, clean and well-groomed • Any hairstyle that is distracting 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tight or revealing clothes (see-through) • Clothing with slits, tears, or holes • Exposed or frayed edges on clothing
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gang related hair styles, hair designs or clipped eyebrows • Facial hair must be well kept, neat and not a distraction 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visible undergarments • Dressing without appropriate undergarments
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cosmetic mouth pieces (Grills) • Skate shoes • Make-up that is distracting (black lipstick, extremely heavy eyeliner) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Large or distracting jewelry, including ear rings • Sweatshirts/Hoodies will remain off head inside the building
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No Jewelry requiring body piercings • No camo allowed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chains (i.e. on wallets, necklaces and waists) • Sagging pants
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exposed Tattoos 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the principal determines that a student’s grooming or clothing violates the school’s dress code, the student will be given an opportunity to correct the problem at school. If not corrected, the student may be assigned to in-school suspension for the remainder of the day, until the problem is corrected. • Repeated offenses may result in more serious disciplinary action in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.
